2. Explanation of the need to be fulfilled by this item(s) and why it is the only one that can meet the specific needs of the department:

Navigate is a comprehensive Student Success Management System used to increase student retention, engagement, and success. Examples of this include providing a complete set of capabilities for monitoring student performance, coordinating intervention and outreach, and automating common tasks and analytics and reporting capabilities to help with data-driven decisions. We currently partner with EAB through the GradesFirst advisor platform. Staff will already be familiar with the platform and functionality. Overall, this comprehensive solution will allow us to better engage our student population and monitor institutional progress.

Based on our needs, we believe that EAB's SSMS, Navigate, is the only tool that can meet the functional and operational requirements established by Mississippi Valley State University to assist with student success.

Navigate includes ongoing consulting and support. EAB's partnership encompasses a set of services and capabilities that are unavailable anywhere else, justifying a sole source procurement.

Mississippi Valley State University has evaluated other sources in the market and concluded that none offers the complete set of functionality and services provided by EAB and Navigate. Through numerous discussions with the vendor about the technological capabilities of Navigate, we have specifically found that the mobile application is more customized, proactive and advanced, comprehensive and seamless as a single platform, capable of producing superior analytics, and finally, Navigate offers the best overall and ongoing support for our users.

As this document demonstrates, EAB's partnership encompasses a set of vital services and capabilities that are unavailable anywhere else. It is due to the uniqueness of the proposed offering that we believe a sole source procurement is justified.

procurement of the commodity to an advertised competitive bid or selection process.

If Mississippi Valley State University determines after review that there is only one (1) source for the required commodity, then MSU will appeal to the Public Procurement Review Board. Mississippi Valley State University will have the burden of proving that the commodity is only provided by one (1) source.
