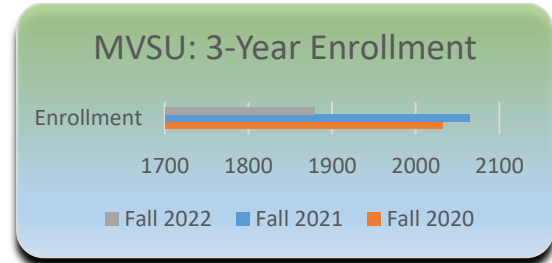




## FALL 2022 ENROLLMENT PROFILE

- The Fall 2022 unduplicated enrollment of 1,879 students represents a decrease of 185 students, or -8.9%, over the Fall 2021 enrollment of 2,064 students. It is -1.8% lower than the Spring 2022 enrollment of 1,914 students.
- 63% of students are commuters. Approximately 694 (37%) live on campus.
- 54% or 1,022 students are from surrounding Delta counties. Most are from Leflore (312), DeSoto (225), Washington (146), Holmes (141), Sunflower (133) followed by Bolivar (85) and Coahoma (54).
- 25% of students are from out-of-state. Most are from TN (106), TX (51), GA (44), and IL (35). There are 21 international students, most are from France.
- 11% of students are Other-Race, including 139 White students.
- There are 452 new students (404 are undergraduates (First-time freshmen, New Transfers, Non-Formula Students) and (48 graduates) who represent 24% of total enrollment.
