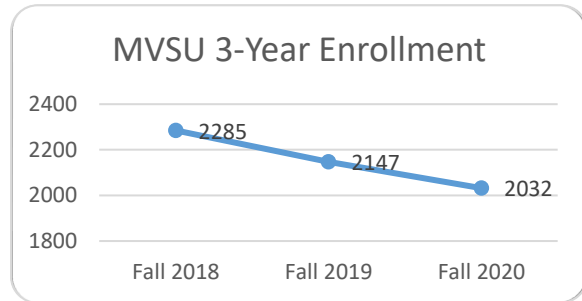




FALL 2020 ENROLLMENT PROFILE

- The Fall 2020 unduplicated **enrollment** of **2,032** students represents a decrease of 115 students, or -5.4%, from the Fall 2019 enrollment of 2,147 students. It is 1% higher than the Spring 2020 enrollment of 2,021 students.
- **71%** of students are **commuters**. Approximately 582 live on campus.
- **65%** or 1,315 students are from surrounding **Delta counties**. Most are from Leflore (399), Washington (258), Sunflower (202), Humphreys (116) and Coahoma (70) counties.
- **24%** of students are from **out-of-state**. Most are from Tennessee (100) and Illinois (61), followed by Georgia (48) and Texas with (46). There are **31 international** students, most are from Nigeria.
- **4%** of students are **Other-Race**, including **29 White** students.
- There are **525 new students** (372 are undergraduates (First-time freshmen, New Transfers, Non-Formula Students) and 153 graduates) who represent 26% of total enrollment.
