




## SPRING 2019 ENROLLMENT PROFILE

- The Spring 2019 unduplicated **enrollment of 2,035** students represents a decrease of 250 students, or -11.0%, over the Fall 2018 enrollment of 2,285 students. It is a -5% decrease from the Spring 2018 enrollment of 2,142 students.
- 61%** of students are **commuters**. Approximately 800 live on campus.
- 66%** or 1,349 students are from surrounding **Delta counties**. Most are from Leflore (459), Washington (196), Sunflower (175), and Humphreys (116) counties.
- 23%** of students are from **out-of-state**. Most are from Tennessee (106), Illinois (74), Texas (46) and Georgia (45). There are **24 international** students, most are from Nigeria.
- 4%** of students are **Other-Race**, including **47 White** students.
- There are 104 **new students** (81 are undergraduates (First-time freshmen, New Transfers and 23 graduates) who represent 5% of total enrollment.
