Fall 2011 Enrollment Profile

- The Fall 2011 unduplicated enrollment of 2,452 represents a decrease of 184 students -7.0% from Fall 2010. The unduplicated Spring 2011 enrollment was 2,524.
- Females make up 63% of total enrollment, 61% of undergraduate enrollment, and 76% of the graduate enrollment.
- Sixty-three percent of students are commuters. Approximately 914 students reside in campus housing.
- Based on enrollment, 1,926 of our currently enrolled students or 79% are from surrounding Delta counties. Most are from Leflore (706), Washington (307), Sunflower (238), Bolivar (129), and Holmes (111) counties.
- Eighteen percent of undergraduates are part-time students while 63% of graduate students are part-time. Overall, the student body is comprised of 610 or 25% part-time students.
- There are 328 First-Time Freshmen (FTF) compared to 387 entering freshmen in Fall 2010. This represents a 15.3% decrease.
- The average ACT composite for entering freshmen is 17.2. This is compared to an average of 17.2 in Fall 2010 and 17.0 in Spring 2011.
- The raw number of out-of-state students is 286. The percentage of enrollment for out-of-state students is 12%. Most of these students are from Illinois (68), Tennessee

(63), and Georgia (28) followed by Texas (21), and California (20).

- White students make up 4% of the total enrollment. The number of White students decreased from Fall 2010 by 10 (10%). It stands at 88.
- There are 545 new undergraduates students. This includes new freshmen, transfers, and Non-formula students 21 and older. Also, there are 100 new graduate students. Altogether, new students represent 26% of the total enrollment.
- Enrollment for International students stands at 35. The majority are from Canada (19).
- The most popular undergraduate majors are Social Work (231), Business Administration (210), HPER (207), and Biology (189), followed by Early Childhood Education (171), and Criminal Justice (158). The most popular graduate majors are Criminal Justice (107), Social Work (91), and MAT (55).
