Subject: **Senior Exit Examination (A Graduation Requirement) AND Testing Schedule**

The Department of Criminal Justice graduating seniors are REQUIRED to take the Senior Exit Examination BEFORE they graduate and/or receive their diploma. The Senior Exit Examination covers five areas: Criminology (CJ382), Law Enforcement (CJ384), Courts (CJ385), Corrections (CJ386) and Research Methods (CJ488). Students may choose to attend one of three testing sessions:

- (1) April 6, 2021 (Tuesday), 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.;
- (2) April 7, 2021 (Wednesday), 3:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.; or
- (3) April 8, 2021 (Thursday), 3:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.

****All sessions will be held at the Department of Criminal Justice, W.A. Butts Social Science Building, Graduate Lecture Hall.**

As indicated above, the Senior Exit Examination is a requirement for graduation. Students who are eligible to take the Senior Exit Examination must register for the exams in advance with the Undergraduate Coordinator via email (recobbs@mvsu.edu) during the semester in which he or she plans to take the exam.

The exam is offered only in the fall and spring semesters of every academic year. Please note that the Senior Exit Examination is NOT offered during the summer sessions. All students who are planning to take the Senior Exit Exam must have completed at least three of the required courses; and, who are currently taking at maximum two of the aforementioned courses during the semester in which he or she is scheduled to sit for the senior exit exam.
