**The Department of Criminal Justice graduating seniors are REQUIRED to take the Senior Exit Examination BEFORE they graduate and/or receive their diploma.** The Senior Exit Examination covers five areas: Criminology, Law Enforcement, Courts, Corrections and Research Methods. Students may choose to attend one of three testing sessions:

- (1) November 7, 2017 (Tuesday), 3:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. at the Social Science Building, Room 18;
- (2) November 8, 2017 (Wednesday), 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. at the Social Science Building, Room 18; or
- (3) November 9, 2017 (Thursday), 3:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. at the Social Science Building, Room 18.
