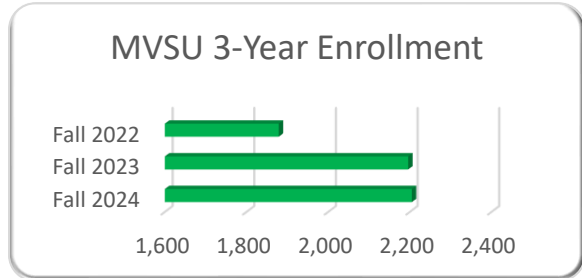




## FALL 2024 ENROLLMENT PROFILE

- The Fall 2024 unduplicated enrollment of 2,205 students represents an increase of 9 students, or .4%, over the Fall 2023 enrollment of 2,196 students. It is 15.7% higher than the Spring 2024 enrollment of 1,905 students.
- 59% of students are commuters. Approximately 900 (41%) live on campus.
- 47% or 1,045 students are from surrounding Delta counties. Most are from Leflore (339), Sunflower (172), Bolivar and Holmes (106), Washington (103), followed by Humphreys (80), and Coahoma, Yazoo (41) each.
- 34% of students are from out-of-state. Most are from TN (235), LA (138), TX (67), and GA (49). There are 24 international students which includes 18 students from France.
- 9% of students are Other-Race, including 117 White students.

- There are 650 new students (593 are undergraduates (First-time freshmen, New Transfers, Non-Formula Students) and (57 graduates) who represent 29% of total enrollment.
