


- The Spring 2022 unduplicated enrollment of 1,914 students represents a decrease of 150 students, or -7.27%, over the Fall 2021 enrollment of 2,064 students. It is a 12.85% increase from the Spring 2021 enrollment of 1,696 students.
- 69% of students are commuters.
 Approximately 601 live on campus.
- 53% or 1,011 students are from surrounding Delta counties. Most are from Leflore (301), Washington (183), Holmes, (144) and Sunflower (107) counties.
- 22% of students are from out-of-state. Most are from Tennessee (84), Texas (50), Georgia (41) and Illinois (39)
- There are 24 international students, most are from Nigeria.

- 13% of students are Other-Race, including
 173 White and 47 Hispanic students.
- There are 65 new students (53 are undergraduates (First-time freshmen, New Transfers and 12 graduates) who represent 3% of total enrollment.
