

- The Spring 2024 unduplicated enrollment of 1,904 students represents a decrease of 292 students, or -13%, from Fall 2023 enrollment of 2,196 students. It is an 11% increase from the Spring 2023 enrollment of 1,714 students.
- 64% of students are commuters.
 Approximately 692 students live on campus.
- 36% or 692 students are from surrounding Delta counties. Most are from Leflore (257), Sunflower (153), Washington (149), Holmes (94), and Bolivar (71) counties.
- 22% of students are from out-of-state. Most are from Tennessee (117), Louisiana (58), Texas (55), and Georgia (38)
- There are 20 international students, most are from Nigeria.

SPRING 2024 ENROLLMENT PROFILE

- 12% of students are Other-Race, including 156 White and 49 Hispanic students.
- There are 90 new students (56 are undergraduates; First-time freshmen & New Transfers and 34 graduates) who represent 5% of total enrollment.
