

SPRING 2025 ENROLLMENT PROFILE

- The Spring 2025 unduplicated enrollment of 1,976 students represents a decrease of 229 students, or -10%, over the Fall 2024 enrollment of 2,205 students. It is an 4% increase from the Spring 2024 enrollment of 1,904 students.
- 61% of students are commuters. Approximately 772 students live on campus.
- 47% or (937) of students are from surrounding Delta counties. Most are from Leflore (258), Sunflower (147), Holmes (122), Humphreys (102), and Washington (82) counties.
- 25% or (492) of students are from out-of-state.
 Most are from Tennessee (149), Louisiana (70),
 Texas (58), Illinois (34) and Georgia (33).
- There are 33 international students, most are from France.
- 13% of students are Other-Race, including 167
 White and 60 Hispanic students.

 There are 68 new students (57 are undergraduates; First-time freshmen & New Transfers and 11 graduates) who represent 3% of total enrollment.
